

The Education Bureau of Kaohsiung City Government 2023 Asian Student Exchange Program (ASEP2023)

I.Origin :

Originating from a collaborative guidance by the Ministry of Education and our Bureau, the AJET project (Advanced Joint English Telecommunication) was officially launched in our city in the year 2000. This year marks the 24th event, co-founded by Professor Chen Nianxing from National Sun Yat-sen University and Professor Kageto Makoto from Nihon Fukushi University. The World Youth Meeting (WYM), held annually between July and August in Nagoya, Japan, and the Asian Student Exchange Program (ASEP), organized in our city around December, during Christmas, have become recurring international exchange extravaganzas between both countries.

This event combines English-themed presentations and information communication technology, forming a regional Asian student internet-based learning and visit exchange event. Over the years, it has fostered collaborative friendships among students and teachers from cross-border schools in the Asia-Pacific region and provided our country's students with opportunities to broaden their global vision.

II.Program Goal :

i.International Education : With the annual theme, students are encouraged to search for international information to make an English presentation to improve their expressing ability and logical thinking skills.

ii.Cultural Literacy : With the cooperation of schools from Asian and New Southbound countries, students will enhance their international cultural knowledge and learn to respect diverse cultures.

iii.International Partner : Invite overseas teachers and students for cultural exchange and establish sister-school partnerships.

III.Administrative Authorities :

i.Organizer : The Education Bureau of Kaohsiung City Government

ii.Public Traffic Information (from abroad) :

- A. Starting from Kaohsiung International Airport : Take Kaohsiung Metro from Kaohsiung International Airport Station (R4) to Weiwuying Station (O10), take exit 1, and walk for around 3 minutes.
- B. Starting from Taoyuan International Airport : Take High Speed Rail (or Taiwan Railway) to Zuoying Station (Kaohsiung), and take Kaohsiung Metro from Xinzuoying Station (R16) to Weiwuying Station (O10), take exit 1, and walk for around 3 minutes. (transferring Metro Line at the Formosa Boulevard Station(R10/O5).

VI.Requirement of participates : Schools in Kaohsiung, such as colleges, universities and secondary schools, must team up with a counterpart from an Asian or New Southbound country.

i.College and University Group : For students currently enrolled in universities, universities of science and technology, two-year or four-year technical colleges or the 4th or 5th grades in junior colleges, all majors are accepted. Each team is limited to 10 participants. (Including Taiwanese Students and Foreign Students)

ii.Senior High School Group : For students currently enrolled in senior high schools or 1st to 3rd grades in junior colleges, all majors are accepted. Each team is limited to 10 participants. (Including Taiwanese Students and Foreign Students)

iii.Junior High School Group : For students currently enrolled in junior high schools or middle schools. Each team is limited to 12 participants. (Including Taiwanese Students and Foreign Students)

iv.Observation Team :

A.Whether schools have participated this event before or not, if schools without an overseas partner school (or fail to match up with any partner school) should join as an Observation team.

B.Participants in Observation teams will be awarded a certificate of participation if

they complete the presentation and join whole events; Observation teams in 2023 will be given priority to join the next year ASEP.

v.Instructors and administrative teacher : Each team may have at most 4 instructors (including 2 from Taiwan and 2 from foreign partner school), and 1 administrative teacher per school (Taiwan School). Instructors and administrative teachers will receive a certificate of participation.

VII.Information of Registration :

i.Contact your partner school in Taiwan to team up, and they will assist with registration. If you do not have a partner school yet, single registration can be accepted, and the Organizer will assist in matching you up. However, if the school fails to find another school to match with, it will be designated as an observation team.

ii.If you haven't had a partner school in Taiwan yet, please fill in the information of online registration form (<http://gg.gg/2023asep-register-eng>) before 5pm, on September 23th, 2023.

iii.After the confirmation of the matched school list, please begin submitting the participant information list by October 13th, 2023. (Foreign schools should submit the list to their Taiwan partner school, and their Taiwan partner school should submit to the Executor.)

VIII.Activities : The 2023 Asian Student Exchange Program is a collaboration between schools in our city and schools of equivalent levels from across Asia and New Southbound countries. Teams will engage in annual themed research projects and presentations. And the whole events have been separated into 3 phases:

i.Phase 1—Online Free Exchange (Before December 24, 2023)

A.Upon acceptance, schools will independently arrange exchange schedule based on the matching results.

B.Schools should discuss the content and methods of presentations related to this year's theme.

C.The thematic online workshop for all participants will take place on November 11th, 2023 (details in Subprogram 1).

D.Partner schools should collaboratively complete the thematic research.

ii.Phase 2—Physical Campus Exchange from December 24, 2023 to December 29, 2023

A.Foreign Teachers and students will gather in Kaohsiung City for in-person

exchange and visits, experiencing cross-cultural interactions. The following activities will be arranged by Taiwan partner school:

a. Specific learning activities: Taiwan schools will arrange for foreign teachers and students to experience local courses, participate in school club activities, immerse in campus life, and practice for the presentations.

b. International exchange and local cultural experiences: Taiwan Partner schools will organize activities including hosting families and city cultural tours, providing an in-depth experience of Taiwanese culture.

B. Schools are responsible for arranging cultural exchange and hosting activities for foreign teachers and students during their visit to Taiwan, including transportation, reception, and homestay arrangements.

C. The international teacher cultural visit is scheduled for the afternoon of December 27, 2023 (details in Subprogram 2).

iii. Phase 3—Presentation Days from December 27, 2023 to December 28, 2023.

A. On the presentation day, teachers and students from each team will collectively present their exchange outcomes, and deliver speeches based on the annual theme and regulations (details in this program, Point IX).

B. The Opening Ceremony and welcome press conference will be held on December 27, 2023, and the Closing and Award Ceremony will take place on December 28, 2023 (details in Subprograms 3 and 4).

C. The Closing Ceremony will feature a segment for Student Cultural Performance Show, providing an excellent stage for students to shine. Participating teams are encouraged to register with the Executor (details in Subprogram 4), if foreign schools are interested in joining in this performance show, please let the Taiwan partner school assist with the registration.

D. Presentations will be divided into "**College and University Group**," "**Senior High School Group**," and "**Junior High School Group**." The event will also be live-streamed on the event's official website.

IX. Annual Theme and Regulations :

i. Annual theme : Promoting the Protection of Human Rights in Reference to SDGs (SDGs 永續發展目標之各種人權促進之道)

The United Nations launched the '2030 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)' and proposed 17 core objectives for global governments and businesses to collectively comply with. These goals emphasized the concept of sustainability and the holistic development of individuals. Furthermore, they align with human rights principles that advocate for dignity, autonomy, inclusivity, equality, and non-discrimination.

Upon reviewing recent high-profile news events, including international conflicts, regional disputes, gender and racial controversies, and the oppression faced by vulnerable groups, it has drawn the attention of all global citizens to acknowledge the

importance of human rights, peace, justice, regulatory transformation, acceptance and understanding. Caring for vulnerable individuals, and to mitigate the impact of the oppression caused by an imbalanced power structure, it requires the formulation of concrete and practical action plans to meet their urgent need. These plans can shed the light on the root of the problems, and take steps to reverse the existing inequalities or biases. Therefore, we invite you to present some of the key conflict issues and propose their measures of their protections based on the indicators of the SDGs.

ii.Presentation Format : The presentation should be in the form of slides, oral reports, or skits. However, for other performing format, please prior to apply to the Executor is required, and the time limit of this performance is 3 minutes.

iii.Presentation Time : The presentation is limited to 8 minutes, followed by a 5-minute interactive Q&A session. Namely, the total time for each team should not exceed 13 minutes. A single bell will ring at 7 minutes to indicate a reminder. Two bells at 8 minutes signal the end of the presentation, so the presenting group must stop.

iv.Interactive Q&A session Time : This session is limited to 5 minutes. A single bell will ring at 4 minutes to indicate a reminder. Two bells at 5 minutes signal the end of the session, so both of the questioning and presenting groups must stop.

v.We divided into "College and University Group, "Senior High School Group," "Junior High School Group." To ensure fair judging and prevent bias, each group will be evaluated and rewarded separately.

vi.Interactive Q&A session : The preceding team must ask 1 to 2 questions, which will be evaluated by the judges, adding up to 0 to 2 points to the final scores, based on their relevance to the presentation contents. After the preceding team's questions, the remaining teams may ask 1 to 2 questions each, with no score deductions or additions. The questioning teams will receive a Q&A gift per team. (Notes: In each group, the last team will ask the first team.)

vii.During the presentation process, if any team deliberately disrupts the order of the events, when the violation is confirmed, the team will be deducted by several points from the final scores.

viii.Scoring Criteria : The scoring criteria are outlined in the following table. Any revision will be based on the latest version and simultaneously announced on the event's official website.

ix. The final results will be based on the Executor announcement. In case of any concerns, teachers from each team can collect appeal forms from the Executor and fill out the issues and submit them to the Executor before 7 PM on December 28, 2023. Late submissions will not be accepted. Appeals must be related to the rules, order of the presentation, and eligibility of participants. Appeals regarding the scoring of the judges and other technical or academic matters are not permitted. If necessary, relevant parties may be informed for clarification. The appeal outcome will be jointly determined by the Organizer, the Executor, and the judges, and a response will be provided to the appellant within 7 working days.

XI. Expected Outcomes :

- i. Reveal students' creativity combining thematic presentation and research features, fostering the students cross-cultural understanding among students from different countries.
- ii. Enhance students' self-learning ability, integrate learning domain, cultivate collaborative learning and problem-solving ability.
- iii. Broaden students' international perspectives, improve the awareness of diverse culture, engage in international affairs discussions, and enrich the concept of global citizens.

XII. Reward :

i. Competition Teams :

Based on the number of teams in a competition group, a certain number of platinum awards, gold awards, honorable mentions will be presented to the winning teams. All the winning teams will receive 2 trophies per team (1 for Taiwan school and 1 for Foreign School) and a certificate of merit for all registered team members.

ii. Observation Teams :

Observation teams may participate in the program, but they will not be awarded any prizes. However, each participating student (based on registration) will receive a

certificate of participation upon completing the presentation and joining in all events.

iii.Instructors and administrative teachers (including Taiwan Schools and foreign schools) :

Instructors and administrative teachers will receive certificates of participation. In addition, Teachers from Taiwan Schools will also receive a commendation record according to the regulation set by the Kaohsiung Education Bureau.

XIII.Others :

- i.**Trophies should be collected on-site, and certificate of merit or certificates of participant will be distributed and delivered after the event. If there are any errors in the certificates, please inform the Executor before February 16th,2024.
- ii.**By registering for the event, the attendance of all meetings and the workshops are required.
- iii.**By registering for the event, you also grant permission for the usage of your portraits and video (taken during the event) for publicity purposes.
- iv.**By registering for the event, you acknowledge the authority of judges and accept the final results.
